The Big Picture

Pocono Mountain Bible Fellowship Church (pmbfc.org) is seeking a bi-vocational pastor to oversee the preaching and teaching ministries, to be the leader for the ministry, and to be a model of personal evangelism and discipleship.

The Church

The Pocono Mountain Bible Fellowship Church (PMBFC) is a member church of the Bible Fellowship denomination. The purpose of the PMBFC is to worship God, edify the saints, and evangelize the world. The church is located just south of Mount Pocono off Route 611 with a weekly service attendance approximately 35 people. The local ministry encompasses all ages, desires to reach out to the local community, and draws upon a diverse social, ethnic and economic neighborhood.

The Candidate

The pastor will be bi-vocational with an eye toward growth and the potential for a full-time position. He will lead the pulpit ministry, serving as the primary Bible expositor. Guided by the Holy Spirit and his discernment of the needs of the church, the pastor's preaching must be Christo-centric, expository and exegetical with applications to the daily life of the church members that are challenging, equipping and edifying. In addition, he must work in full partnership with the Board of Elders as a joint decision making and serving body.

The Qualifications

We require a man that meets the qualifications in I Timothy and Titus. College degree in Bible/Theology required, seminary degree a plus. Must be in agreement with the Bible Fellowship Church's Articles of Faith and Principles of Order. Minimum of five years' experience in a similar ministry position.
